Colossians 1:15-23

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Discussion Questions

1. Think about how distracted your own life is. What does it look like? What impact is it having on your relationships and state of mind?
2. Read Colossians 1:15-23. If our salvation depends upon the grace of God, not us, why is it necessary for us to “continue in your faith, established and firm, not moved” (“distracted and diverted” in The Message)
 - a. What is the danger of becoming distracted and diverted in our spiritual life?
3. How does Jesus’ death on the cross make us reconciled with God? How does it change your life to believe that?
4. What steps could you take this week to stay “established and firm, not moved” in your relationship with Jesus? Have each person give their word to one action step.

Key Verse “But now he has reconciled you by Christ’s physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation-- if you continue in your faith, established and firm, not moved from the hope held out in the gospel.” (Colossians 1:22-23a, NIV)
