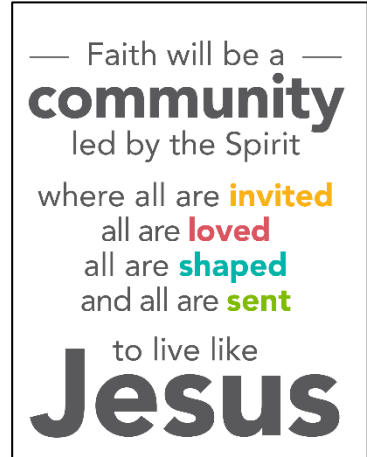




## A Pentecostal Vision for Faith CRC “where all are invited”



### Home Church Questions – May 30, 2021

1. Opening: What’s the best or most memorable invitation you’ve received?
2. Last week, we began our new Vision Statement series by looking at the phrase “a community led by the Spirit” (John 14:11-27). If your group did not meet last week, consider starting here:
  - a. What does it mean for you personally, for you as a Home Church, or for us as Faith Church to be led by the Spirit? How can we grow in this area?
  - b. Pastor Cara suggested that we work to look like Baby Yoda with a Hawaiian shirt. What is one specific change you might introduce in order to have bigger ears (to hear God’s truth), bigger eyes (to see God at work), and bigger colours (to experience the freedom, power, and peace of Jesus through the Spirit)?
3. Today we spent a few minutes considering Jesus’ invitation in Matthew 11:28-30. Read it aloud from the Message paraphrase and one other translation.
  - a. How is Jesus’ invitation similar or different to invitations in today’s culture?
  - b. Have you received Jesus’ invitation? What is one way you might lean further into his invitation in your daily life?
  - c. Envision one of the vulnerable or marginalized persons you know. What is one change Faith Church should prayerfully consider in order to be a community of rest, gentleness, and interdependence for this person? Pray about this idea and consider sharing it with Pastor Cara or Council.

Close by sharing joys and concerns and praying for one another and for Faith Church.
