

Home Church Questions - November 21, 2021

1. Opening: Do you send thankyou cards? Why or why not? *Or:* If you were to write a thankyou note today, to whom would you write, and why?
2. Imagine you've been given \$1 million, instructed that you must give it all away immediately to organizations (Christian or not Christian) that contribute to the mission of reconciliation and restoration, broadly understood. Which organizations (or what type of cause) would you give to, and why? Put differently, what type of need / brokenness in God's world are you most passionate about addressing?
3. What does Paul mean by "partnership in the gospel" (1:5)? What does God do for Paul and for the Philippian church through this partnership?
4. Why is the Core Practice "We engage in need-oriented mission" important for Faith Church, and for you?
5. In this sermon series, we've looked at 4 of our 5 Core Practices (relationships, worship, gifts for ministry, and need-oriented mission); we also had a short message about God's Mission (on Service Sunday). What is one insight or practice you'll take with you from this series? *Or:* Imagine someone saying, "I don't need church. I can follow Jesus on my own." How would you respond?

Close by sharing your joys and concerns and praying together.

Consider whether Jesus is nudging you to a particular task this week and ask your Home Church to hold you accountable.
