Home Church Questions

1. Outside of a family member, who is the person you trust the most in your life? What qualities make that person trustworthy?
2. This may be challenging for some, but give each other grace and space. Can you describe a time when trust was broken in your life? What impact has that had on your relationship with God and others?
3. Read Philippians 3:7-11.
 - What does Paul mean in verse 10 when he talks about knowing the power of Christ's resurrection?
 - What does he mean in the same verse when he says that he wants to become like Jesus in his death?
 - How do these phrases connect to what we have learned about authenticity and our own Christian walk?
4. The message closed with an ancient Irish story about "chancing the arm." Share that story in your group with those who may not have heard it. Take a moment to reflect and answer this question: who is Jesus challenging you to chance your arm with this week as you take a risk for Him?
5. Close by praying for each others joys and needs
